Paul has told us, it's the only reasonable response to the amazing mercies of God displayed in the gospel. and he's going to spell out for us what it would look like in practice. But before he does, he tells us, in Romans 12:2, about something that has to happen first.

Explain what it means to be conformed to the world.

- ◆ What does the word "transformed" tell us about what Paul says must happen to us?

◆ How does Paul say we should be transformed?

◆ Paul doesn't say explicitly how God renews minds. He assumes that we will be able to work that out for ourselves. How does God renew minds?

◆ What does Paul say will be the outcome of having our minds renewed?

◆ What does Paul mean by the will of God in this verse?

◆ What do you personally need to do if you are to have your mind renewed as Paul says you should?
