God did spare Judah in king Josiah's day, but when he died disaster came quickly. Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, besieged Jerusalem, destroyed the city, left Judah a wasteland and carried its citizens into exile. You can read about it in 2 Chronicles 36:1 – 21.
