Of course there are difficulties in understand parts but really, if these chapters are considered in context and if it is remembered that they are Jesus answer to the question posed by His disciples in Matthew 24:3, then the main points are clear.

- How can you prepare for the kind of things Jesus says will happen?

- What does Jesus say about the timing of His return (Matthew 24:14, 36 – 37, 44 and Mark 13:32)?

- What do you learn from Jesus' story comparing faithful and an unfaithful slaves (Matthew 24:45 – 51)?

- What do you learn from the parable of the ten virgins (Matthew 25:1 – 13)?

- What do you learn from the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14 – 30)?

- What are you led to expect to happen when Jesus returns by His words in Matthew 25:31 – 36?
