

The work with the adults is bearing fruit. The group has become more stable and we see growth. A good number of children are still regularly attending the meetings. We are now working with a new generation of kids. Many of the children who came to us when we first planted the work are now mothers themselves. It is difficult to see them make the same mistakes as their parents but the good seed has been sown in their hearts and we pray that the Lord would have mercy on these young lives.



We have been encouraged in that some of these young girls are once again coming along to the meetings. We would ask you to pray especially for Jhenny. I think Jhenny began coming to church the first month we were in Pachacutec and subsequently made a profession of faith and was baptized. Some months later she became involved with a young man who professed to be a Christian but was anything but. Jhenny abandoned her faith and after finishing her relationship with this young man started to cohabit with a new partner. For a couple of years she wanted nothing to do with us or God. However, for about a month now she has been faithfully coming along to the Sunday evening services and the Bible Studies on Wednesday. Please pray for Jhenny and her partner. They have a beautiful little daughter and our hearts desire is to see Jhenny fully restored in her faith and to see her partner and little daughter saved.

Every so often she appears at the Wednesday night Bible study and insists that one day she will succeed in bringing her partner to church. We have done our best to guide and counsel her but we can't change hearts. Please pray with us for Nelly. We know that nothing is impossible with the Saviour.

A couple of years ago we shared with you a problem with one of the schools in Pachacutec. The building was wooden and falling down and so a group of parents took the school director and some of the teacher hostage demanding a new school building. One of the leaders was Nelly's mother and the school director was the grandmother of another family who came to our children's meetings. It was complicated to say the least. Anyway, the children now have a new school building. We are not sure that it is the best way to get a new school, but in this case it worked!



We would also ask you to remember our niece Ybi in prayer. She is suffering from breast cancer and the treatments she is receiving don't appear to be having much affect. She will be having 6 radiotherapies and then possibly the decision will be made to operate. Ybi is in her early thirties and is a Christian. The church she is involved with have been a great encouragement to her but as expected there are times when she gets discouraged.



In closing we want to thank each one of you for your continued support. We remember the work at Killicomaine in prayer and are encouraged to hear how the Lord is blessing you.
